

Important Update for patients diagnosed with Opioid Addiction or Opioid Use Disorder

Scientific advancements have been made. New information is available. At least some of the people diagnosed with Opioid Addiction or Opioid Use Disorder have been found instead to have a type of damage to their DNA. This type of damage is known medically as a METHYLATION. This type of methylation associated with the opioids has been known since 2009. But this is the first time that a DNA test has been available to the public. The test is currently undergoing a very rigorous HHS process known as CLIA Certification.
